The Summit Men's Soccer Program prides itself for being the preeminent soccer program in Cincinnati. Since its inception in 1980, SCD has been recognized for athletic and academic achievements at city, state, regional and national levels.

For 30 years, the Silver Knights have been well-known for collecting hardware. The Summit is one of only three Cincinnati high schools to have won a State title in the past fifteen years, across all divisions. The Summit is also the last Catholic (and only Independent) school from Cincinnati to have won a state title.

The schedule includes some of the top teams in the country. After the 1999 season, area Division I & II schools began dropping The Summit from their schedules because they couldn't consistently compete with them.

So, the men's program now travels to play the very best teams willing to take on the Silver Knights. Last year SCD played teams that had won a combined 21 state championships, including Finalists and Champions from Indiana, Pennsylvania and Kentucky, as well as the very best teams from Toledo, Columbus, Akron, and Cleveland.

The Summit coaching staff has a distinct process when counseling players about playing at the next level. Colleges always keep SCD on their radar. In the past 20 years 14 players have gone on to play NCAA Division I soccer and others have gone on to play at various intercollegiate levels. Alums have played at: Notre Dame, Louisville, South Carolina, Kentucky, Xavier, Cincinnati, Ohio State, Richmond, etc. Two alums went on to be named NCAA Division I All Americans, another was named to a US Soccer National Pool, and yet another was selected in the first round of the MLS SuperDraft by the Chicago Fire!
