The Summit Country Day School boasts one of the preeminent soccer programs in Ohio. Since its inception in 1980, The SCD men's soccer teams have been recognized for athletic and academic achievements at city, state, regional and national levels.

The men's program has been synonymous with championships for the past 20 years. The Silver Knights have won 12 Miami Valley Conference titles, 10 district trophies, appeared in eight regional finals, and captured the 1999 State Championship.

The Summit is one of only three Cincinnati high schools to have won a soccer State Championship in the past fifteen years, across all divisions. SCD is also the last Catholic school (and only Independent school) from Cincinnati to have won a state title.

Upcoming schedules include some of the best teams in the country. The program plays teams that have won the last 5 Ohio Division III State Championships, along with State Finalists from Indiana, Pennsylvania, Kentucky, and Toledo, Columbus and Cleveland.

College coaches always keep The Summit on their radar. The Cincinnati Player of the Year has come from SCD four out of past five years. Within the past 15 years, The Summit has had three of the seven Cincinnati players named High School All American. One SCD alum was even named an NCAA Division I All American. While another was named to the US Soccer National Pool.

16 former players have gone on to play NCAA Division I soccer, and dozens of others have gone on to play for other colleges.
