Individual Achievements and Team Information:

Summit has many athletes that have received league, city and state recognition. The past 16 years have produced 7 MVC Player of the Year awards, 49 All City recognitions (including 1 city Player of the Year) & 6 All-State commendations. Many Summit alumnae have lettered in college at all levels. Division I representation includes Bowling Green, Charlotte, Cincinnati, Davidson, Duke, Eastern Kentucky, Florida, Georgia, George Washington, Kentucky, Northeastern, Purdue, Rice, South Carolina, Toledo & Xavier. The team just completed its 30th season and has won 12 MVC titles in 20 years.

We were MVC and Sectional Champions this season.

Above all these accomplishments, the Summit girl's soccer program stresses personal growth, teamwork, leadership and sportsmanship. Southwest Ohio awarded the team with the **Team Sportsmanship Award for 2008**. Each athlete, whether a senior varsity captain or a freshmen JV newcomer is welcomed as an equal member of the team. **Academic excellence is part of the program that produced a team GPA of 3.89 during the 2009 year.**

The 2009 Varsity team

was nationally recognized for outstanding academic achievement with the NSCAA/Adidas High School Team Academic Award. This national award was presented to only a total of 243 out of 20,000 high school girls teams. We are one of only 24 Ohio schools awarded and had the 3rd highest GPA in the state. Two seniors were awarded as Scholar East region, two of only 54 in the country to receive this award in 2009.
