



MIDDLE SCHOOL (7th/8th) BOYS LACROSSE Spring 2012 Information and Registration

Eligibility & Background

- 7th and 8th Grade Boys
- The Middle School team is considered a ‘club’ team, governed by Southern Ohio Middle School Lacrosse and US Lacrosse rules and guidelines.
- According to the 2011 Tournament Seeding SCD is in Division 3.
- Eligibility as determined by Southern Ohio Lacrosse Chapter guidelines: If a player’s school offers a program, the player is expected to play for his school. Generally, if his school does not offer lacrosse, the player is expected to play in the community he resides.
- Eligibility is not limited to Summit students and athletes from neighboring schools may join the team if there are roster openings.

About Middle School Lacrosse

Middle School lacrosse is, first and foremost, developmental. The focus of the program is on preparing players for High School and beyond. Skills, abilities and experience levels are very diverse at this level. No previous experience is necessary. The only requirement for success is a desire to improve and good physical conditioning.

Cost

There is not a participation fee for Summit students although every player is required to be a member of US Lacrosse (cost \$25 per year). Players not enrolled at Summit are required to pay the \$250 participation fee. All players must supply their own equipment (helmet, stick, mouth guard, gloves, arm pads, shoulder pads, protective cup and cleats).

Season / Practices / Games

- Practice begins Monday, February 13, 2012
- Practices are 3 days a week – days & times to be determined
- “Official” games begin Saturday, March 3, 2012

- Game days are Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday – dates & times to be determined
- Number of games 10-15, plus Tournament
- Season ends with the OMSLA tournament in Dublin, OH on May 12-13, 2012

Registration Process

Step 1. US Lacrosse Membership

Every player is required to be a member of US Lacrosse. Returning players must be sure their membership is renewed for the 2012 season and all new players must register with US Lacrosse. Associate your member number with Summit Country Day Youth.

Go to <http://www.uslacrosse.org>. “Join now – Become a Member” is on the left side of the page. Click on “Join/Renew” or “Look up your Member #”. You will need this number to register online for Summit Boys Middle School Lacrosse.

Step 2. Summit Boys Middle School (7-8) Lacrosse Registration

All players will register using the Summit K6 Athletics Online Registration & Payment Program.
