

**Summit Country Day Youth Lacrosse
PLAYER AND PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT**

PLAYERS:

1. I will exhibit strong character and leadership – the expectations are no different than those of my School.
2. I am a 'student-athlete' (in that order)...School work always comes first.
3. I will show a positive and constructive attitude toward my teammates, coaches, opponents and referees. I will show restraint and respect toward officials. Only coaches are allowed to address the officials during games. I agree that arguing with coaches and referees will directly affect my playing time and progress against agreed-upon goals.
4. I understand that any fighting, throwing of equipment or similar inappropriate conduct will result in removal from the team.
5. I agree to work hard, follow the rules, learn the game of lacrosse and above all, have fun.

PARENTS:

1. I understand that my son's participation in Summit Youth Lacrosse binds him and us to the School's Athletics Code of Conduct. If I'm not familiar with the Code of Conduct, I'll arrange to obtain a copy and become familiar with it.
2. I understand that Youth Lacrosse is developmental and practice is very important. Inadequate practice time is not fair to my son or the team. Therefore, I pledge to have my son to practice and games on time. If my son will not be able to attend practice or games on time, I'll notify one of the coaches in advance. Further, if my son frequently misses or arrives late for practice, I'll fully respect the Coaches' discretion in limiting his playing time.
3. I understand the importance of setting a good example for our players. Therefore, I will show respect for all involved in the game including coaches, players, opponents, opposing fans and officials. I understand that Youth Lacrosse referees often are also learning the game and will refrain from criticizing them for mistakes or perceived bad calls.
4. I will refrain from yelling instruction to my son or other players during games since this is the role of the coaches. Lacrosse is fast-paced and chaotic and our players are trying to respond to opponents, teammates and coaches. I'll limit my comments to cheering and encouraging my son and other players.

We will honor this Code of Conduct in my words and actions.
