REGISTRATION PROCESS -- Complete the registration form on the following page using a separate form for each player. *Send registration form and check for 85.00 for each player (payable to Summit Boosters) to SAY Soccer Volunteer, Summit Country Day School, 2161 Grandin Rd, Cin. 45208... Please Add 15 for short/socks or shirts or 30 for complete uniform*

FALL SEASON 2009– The Fall season is open to all 1st-6th graders at the Summit. It is a ten game outdoor season, tentatively scheduled for early September thru October. Games are played on Saturdays and Sundays versus other Eastside schools/organizations on fields assigned by SAY (Soccer Association for Youth). We will not know our field assignments and game schedules until the week before the season begins. Practice frequency is determined by your coach. Most Summit teams will practice once per week.

PAID SOCCER TRAINER- In hopes of developing the soccer skills required to play at a higher level, the Summit Boosters have contracted with Challenger Sports to provide a professional trainer for all 1st-6th students playing Say soccer at the Summit. Trainings will be with their team once a week, usually 1-1 ½ hours in length. This is in addition to the regular team training. **Participation in team training is required, not optional. We are required to provide housing for the trainer. Please consider housing this fine young man from England. It can be a very rewarding experience not only for your soccer player but family.**

TEAM FORMATION – Players are grouped by gender and age/grade and assigned randomly. Teams will try to be divided based on equal ages and skill levels. We will do our best to make every team competitive. Late registrants are not guaranteed placement on teams. The following chart shows the age matrix.

Passers 08/01/01-7/31/03

Wings 08/01/99-7/31/01

Strikers 08/01/97-7/31/99

Teams are formed based on the above age matrix. A player may play up to be with his grade, but cannot play down.

UNIFORMS -- Game day uniform consists of a royal blue jersey, shorts and soccer socks. New players can purchase a full uniform via the registration form (“Full Uniform”). Returning players have three options: 1) for complete uniform select “Full”, 2) for a new shirt select “Jersey only”, 3) for no uniform, select “None required.”

COST – Registration fee covers: SAY fees, referee costs, team equipment, individual trophies (1-3) t-shirt (4-6), team photos, and professional trainers. Be certain to select the appropriate uniform request box on the Registration form: **\$85** --For player ordering NO uniform, **\$100** – For player ordering uniform jersey or Shorts/socks only, **\$115** – For player needing FULL uniform (shirt, shorts and socks). Parents are Responsible for purchasing shin guards, soccer/gym shoes and a soccer ball, all of which are required at each practice and game. You can also order Summit soccer spirit wear. A hooded sweatshirt with name on the back for **\$26** or a Summit soccer t-shirt for **\$6**.

COACHES – Please consider volunteering as a coach where indicated on the registration form. All coaches are required to do a background check, fingerprinting and a class with Father Seher. All coaches are also asked to attend a coach’s clinic, location to be announced. Please consider volunteering, there can be no greater reward.
