- Your registration form is due by March 26. It helps us to understand the number of openings we have for players from other schools.
- This year, if it is helpful, only a portion of your fees are due by Fitting Day, tentatively April 17. This will enable us to order uniforms and equipment on time.
- The balance is due by August 2 so we are able to pay the remainder of our expenses. Thank you for your cooperation.

### What are the teams?

**Pony team** - 3rd & 4th graders - 120 lb. limit

### When are the games? (dates are tentative)

Saturday or Sunday afternoons

Regular season August 28 – October 24 & Playoffs October 30 – November 14

### When are the practices?

- Voluntary summer conditioning workouts begin the week of July 26
- Football practice begins Monday, August 2, 2010 - We have only 4 weeks of practice before our first game, so please schedule vacations prior to August 2.
- 4 evening practices a week until school begins
- 2 practices a week after school begins
- Saturday morning walk-throughs
- Scrimmages to be announced

### Why do we register so early?

- We need to know how many players are on each team so we know how many openings there are for players from other schools.
- There is a Fitting Day (tentatively April 17) to measure each player for a **NEW HELMET** (provided by the Boosters) and **NEW UNIFORMS** (blue with white side stripe) and to insure we have the other necessary equipment in our inventory. We will place our order immediately in order to have part of the equipment distributed in May. The balance will be distributed in August.

## **What does it cost?**

- Fees are \$210 and are fully refundable until Fitting Day (tentatively April 17). You may receive a partial refund (\$100) until August 2.
  - \$110 deposit must be paid by Fitting Day (tentatively April 17<sup>th</sup>) & is non-refundable after this date – we will purchase the helmets, jerseys, game pants, and under armour type shirts immediately
  - \$100 balance must be paid by August 2 & is non-refundable after this date
  - If you require a different plan, we can arrange it – please let Ted know
- For players registering after April Fitting Day (exception: new students), fees increase to \$225
- Unfortunately, with a new style uniform, we are unable to wear previous jerseys
- Fees include
  - The complete uniform and equipment (helmet, shoulder pads, game jersey with your last name, practice jersey, game pants, practice pants, pads, chin strap, under armour type shirt, socks, and mouthguard)
  - All players keep their game jersey, under armour type shirt, socks, & mouthguard
  - Pictures & end of season awards
- Fees do not include cleats or additional protective equipment
- If your son would prefer to wear an integrated girdle & knee pads instead of using our pad set in the practice and game pants, the cost is an additional \$25. This can be ordered at Fitting Day and of course, they are yours to keep.

## **What are the dates I need to put in my calendar now?**

- March 26 - deadline for Registration form
- April 17 (tentative) - Fitting Day; deadline for \$110 non-refundable deposit; last day for full refund; fees increase after this date to \$225
- May 15 and/or 22 (tentative) - Equipment Distribution Day
- July 26 - Summer conditioning week; you will be able to register in advance for the best price (\$8 per session) or just show up (\$15 per session)
- August 2 - First practice (no more vacations please); deadline for balance (\$100) of fees; last day for partial refunds

## **What are the volunteer requirements?**

This is a parent-run sport; therefore, each family is expected to help at some of the home games during both the regular season and the playoffs. Volunteer positions are plentiful and are listed on the registration form.
