***I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.**

***I will never enter the playing surface at any time.**

***I will never confront in anger a coach, official, player, spectator, or league official before, during or after any game.**

***I will never use objectionable language or behavior that is detrimental to the game or the Summit K-6 Program.**

***I will at no time call or contact an official about any infraction of any game or for any other reason.**

All players, coaches, parents and commissioners are expected to exhibit good sportsmanship and team values, and to generally uphold the principles and objectives of the Summit K-6 Parent Run Program. Any person associated with the program not exhibiting high standards of common decency may be removed from the program at the discretion of the Board of Commissioners.
