Dear Parents:

We are getting in gear for a great season of football cheerleading in the fall! There are two pre-7th grade squads: the 3rd & 4th grade squad, and the 5th & 6th grade squad.

If your child will enter 3rd, 4th, 5th or 6th grade in the 2007-2008 academic year, she is eligible to join one of the squads.

Last year, we had a blast – performing a dance routine at The Summit’s Varsity Homecoming Game at half-time, cheering with the varsity and junior varsity girls during the homecoming game, and cheering on our own 3rd & 4th grade, and 5th & 6th grade football teams on Sunday afternoons.

To help us prepare for the upcoming season, we have a two-part plan for the summer:

Part one: Hyde Park Gymnastics will offer an exclusive cheerleading camp just for us: **July 9 – 11, noon – 2 p.m.** During those three days, we will learn new cheerleading chants, simple mounts, and special cheerleading skills such as cartwheels and tumbling. The cost per cheerleader is \$75. See attached form.

Part two: a second “camp” in mid-August (tentatively scheduled for Aug. 13 – 17) at the Summit – at no charge, of course. We will spend about two hours each day practicing chants, creating half-time dance routines, ordering uniforms, and otherwise getting organized for the

season. We would like to separate the two squads so that each squad can have its own practice during most of this week.

Meanwhile, last year's cheerleaders should dig in the closet, pull out uniforms/gear, and find out what fits, what doesn't and what's missing (what about those pom-poms?).

Parents, we need lots of help. We especially need someone (or two or three) to take the lead with the 3rd & 4th grade squad. No experience necessary.

Finally, I hope everyone attends the Football Moms Clinic ("Everything you wanted to know about football, but were afraid to ask") with former ESPN Anchor Betsy Ross on Tuesday, June 19 at 6 p.m. Kathy Nourse (513-528-1321) is planning a wonderful, fun and educational event for the women of Summit.
